

NOTICE TO CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSE HOLDERS

The following information identifies some areas where the possession of firearms is regulated under federal and/or state laws. It is not an all inclusive listing. Regulations are subject to change and some may or may not apply to Concealed Handgun License holders. We cannot give specific advice for individual sites, but it is in the CHL holder's best interest to investigate for themselves and obtain the correct information before taking a concealed handgun to any of the following locations:

FEDERAL:

1. Federal Facilities owned or leased by the U.S. Government
2. Federal Courthouses
3. Post offices
4. Airport property
5. Protected National Wilderness areas
6. Military Reservations
7. Indian Reservations
8. Indian Gaming casinos
9. Endangered Species areas

STATE:

1. Courtroom, jury rooms, judge's chambers or the areas adjacent thereto, to be determined by the presiding judge.
2. Posted private property
