

I am return to you your ATF application, mailed to the Sheriff's Office. The process for obtaining the Sheriff's signature has change effective 07/01/2009. Application must be delivered in person, were we will take a copy of your driver's license and you are required to pay \$35.00 for a background check.

The above is the current however under the new leadership of Sheriff Dan Staton, the signature of the Sheriff on all ATF application process has been halted for the entire county, due to Sheriff Staton desire to review the counties position on resident's registering the qualified machinery.

I anticipate a decision from the Sheriff in the next 30-days on whether or not the Sheriff's Office will continue the practice of reviewing and signing ATF Applications. At this time, there are no other signatures that can be obtained to fulfill this CLEO requirement, Chiefs of Police will only refer you back the Sheriff's Office.
