SUMMARY

Creates crime of unlawfully transferring large capacity magazine. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to large capacity magazines.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the crime of unlawfully trans
 - ferring a large capacity magazine if the person knowingly sells, or
- 6 otherwise transfers for consideration, a large capacity magazine.
- 7 (2) This section does not apply to the sale or transfer for consider-
- 8 ation of a large capacity magazine to:
- 9 (a) A law enforcement unit of the federal government or a law enforcement unit as defined in ORS 181.610; or
- 11 (b) The active or reserve military forces of this state or of the 12 United States.
- 13 (3) Unlawfully transferring a large capacity magazine is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 15 (4) As used in this section, "large capacity magazine" means any 16 ammunition feeding device with the capacity to accept more than 10 17 rounds of ammunition, but does not include:
- 18 (a) A feeding device that has been permanently altered so that it 19 cannot accommodate more than 10 rounds of ammunition.
- 20 (b) A tubular magazine that is contained in a lever action firearm.
 - (c) A 0.22 caliber tube ammunition feeding device.
